



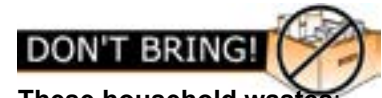

These household wastes:

- No household goods or Styrofoam
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic bags, toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE
- No paint of any kind
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

Take hazardous waste to the **North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility - 12550 Stone Ave N, Seattle, WA 98133. Hours: Sunday–Tuesday, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Closed on major holidays.** There is a limit of 25 gallons of gasoline and a limit of 50 gallons of other automotive fluids per trip. Containers should be labeled and must be 5 gallons or smaller. Customers can have gas containers back upon request. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. No latex paint is accepted. Visit www.paintcare.org/wa for more information on paint collection.

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$3 for extra tires off rim. \$6 for all passenger tires on rims. \$15 charged for each large truck tire and \$30 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, motorcycle, and sealed lead acid batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. **No rechargeable, cell phone, or nicad batteries accepted. Lithium-ion batteries, like tool and vape batteries, will not be accepted. Visit the batterynetwork.org for more battery recycling options.**

- **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors, mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers. **\$5.00 cash only charge for each printer and copier.** For free regular collection of TVs, computers, and monitors visit EcycleWA.org.
 - **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (no charge).
 - **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions. Visit <https://www.atg.wa.gov/upcoming-events> for more paper shredding options.
 - **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$10 (cash only).**
 - **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$25 charge (cash only).**
 - **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$35 (cash only)** for each refrigerator or freezer. **\$35 (cash only)** for each household air conditioner. **Refrigerators or freezers cannot be sealed or contain food.**
 - **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (**drained of oil and gasoline**), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain **gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials** will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted.
 - **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No peg board, particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
 - **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS:** Mattresses and box springs, any size. **\$35 (cash only)** per mattress and **\$35 (cash only)** per box spring. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.
- NO CARDBOARD: Please recycle cardboard in your curbside recycling bin.**

Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit ecyclewa.org to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. Residents may drop off TVs, computer monitors, desktop and laptop computers, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players at no charge at the following locations: St. Vincent de Paul (7304 Bothell Way, Kenmore, WA, 98028, 425-483-9497. Note: Televisions must be 25" or smaller.) and Goodwill Shoreline Store (14500 15th Avenue NE, Shoreline, WA, 98105), (206) 631-8454. Drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events. **Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.**

Rain Barrel and Compost Bin Sale

All items \$25 each. Cash only. While supplies last. No pre or post event sales.

To encourage the use of recycled content material and more efficient use of water, your City is offering discounted recycled plastic rain barrels. In addition, start backyard composting with a compost bin to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left.
